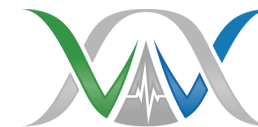

Fees and Payments

Doctors on Darling is a private billing practice. Our consultation fees are outlined below (fee list as at 1 July 2021.)

Note: All consultations on Saturdays incur an additional \$10 charge. Out of hours appointments (before 8.00am) will also incur higher fees. Procedures, dressings and certain immunisations incur an additional fee to the consultation fee. If this is the case, your doctor will inform you of this prior to their use.

Bulk billing is only available to certain concession card holders. Please discuss this with your doctor.

Appointments

For all appointments, please phone (02) 8068 2490 or book online via www.doctorsondarling.com.au

We will make every effort to accommodate your preferred time and doctor. However, when this is not possible, you will be offered the first available appointment with any doctor. Home visit's are available at the Doctors discretion and will incur a \$200.00 out of pocket fee.. Appointments are scheduled at 15 minute intervals, **one patient per appointment**. To assist us to run on time, if you feel you require a **longer appointment** to deal with **numerous or complex issues, or if you have more than one family member to be seen, please advise at time of booking.**

Cancellations

Please advise Reception in advance if you are unable to make your appointment to enable this appointment to be offered to another patient in need.

For pre-booked appointments, SMS reminders are sent to the nominated mobile number. (Reply Yes to confirm or No to cancel)

Referrals

An important aspect of general practice is the provision of continuity of care. To ensure that you receive the best possible care, we need to see you before referring you to a specialist. On receipt of your referral it is highly recommended that you schedule an appointment with the specialist as soon as possible, as often there is a 4-6week waiting period.

Your GP may be able to request an urgent appointment should they feel that your condition requires immediate attention. (This is done at the time of your referral). **We are unable to 'back date' referrals.**

Repeat Prescriptions / Lost Forms

Most repeat prescriptions require an appointment as in most cases it is necessary for the doctor to re-examine you. Occasionally and at the doctor's discretion, a script or referral may be provided without an appointment. (A \$30.00 pre paid fee may apply) .

If you have lost a prescription, pathology request form or referral this can be replaced without an appointment. (A \$30.00 pre paid fee may apply) .

Results , Recalls and Follow-Ups

Doctors are unable to discuss test results over the telephone due to medico-legal requirements. Therefore, follow up appointments are required. For all other results, Reception will call and schedule an appointment as directed by the doctor.

The doctors at this medical practice will include you (unless otherwise notified) in our database for reminders such as pap smears, immunisations and other preventative health care issues.

Contacting your Doctor

Your doctor is accessible by phone, however, we ask that phone calls are kept to a minimum and that you simply schedule an appointment should you need to discuss an issue with them, this appointment could be a telehealth appointment. This will also assist in avoiding disruptions to consultations in progress.

Reception can promptly email the doctor internally and request a return phone call to be made based upon the urgency. Please indicate to the receptionist the general nature of your call, as in many cases, they will be able to assist you with any queries or concerns that you may have.
